Youth Guidelines

1. Pieces must be original work that you, the artist, have designed and crafted and not previously shown at the Magnolia Arts Sidewalk Art Show. Work must have been completed in the last two years.
2. **You may enter two works of art per category.**
3. One entry form per person...this piece of paper.
4. All work should be clearly marked with identification labels. These are different than entry form.
5. Please pick your art up Saturday May 19th after 2 pm.

All art must be submitted by Tuesday, May 15th by 7:00pm

You may enter two works of art per category

Youth Category Explanation

2D Painting: oils, acrylics, watercolor, tempera, etc.

2D Drawing: chalk, charcoal, pen and ink, pastels, pencils, wax crayons, etc.

2D Mixed Media: incorporates more than one type of material

Photography: prints made from the artist original image

Digital: the use of computers to create and edit traditional work

Ceramics: original functional or sculptural clay or porcelain work

3D/Functional Art: Stain glass, furniture, woodwork, sculpture (3D work in any medium), fibers (quilting, needlework, etc.), jewelry, etc.
